#### INCLUSIONARY HOUSING - Low Income Waiting List Rent Stabilization Division, City of West Hollywood (323) 848-6450

The City administers an Inclusionary Housing Program, in which a percentage of housing units are made available to low income households.

If you are currently on the City's waiting list and would like to request a change to any of your household information, please contact the Rent Stabilization Division at (323) 848-6450.

Currently, all low-income units in the program are occupied. The waiting list is closed to new applications. It will be reopened when there is sufficient new residential construction. The waiting list is prioritized by factors established by the City Council, such as current rent, urgency of need such as risk of homelessness from Ellising, age, income qualification and West Hollywood residency.
