TO PARTICIPATE BY PROVIDING WRITTEN CORRESPONDENCE OR AN E-COMMENT:

Members of the public who wish to comment on matters before the City Council are <u>strongly</u> <u>encouraged</u> to submit written correspondence to <u>publiccomment@weho.org</u> or submit an E-Comment by visiting <u>www.weho.org/wehotv</u> no later than 2:00 p.m. on Council meeting day. Note: Written Correspondence and E-Comments <u>will not</u> be read into the record during the City Council meeting; however, correspondence received by 2:00 p.m. will be forwarded to the City Council and posted on the City's website as part of the official meeting record. Your comments and information will become part of the official public record. <u>If you do not want your</u> <u>personal information included in the official record</u>, <u>please do not include your address and/or</u> <u>phone number</u>.

TO PARTICIPATE BY PROVIDING PUBLIC COMMENT BY TELEPHONE:
