The Commission commented on replacing current public parking, space for rideshare and other modes of transportation, electric vehicle charging stations, traffic impacts, parking impacts, relying on projected driver behaviors versus actual driver behaviors and possibly dated traffic study.

B. Santa Monica Boulevard Protected Bicycle Lanes Feasibility Study

The Commission received a report from Bob Cheung.

Helen Krieger, WEST HOLLYOOD, spoke about having protected bike lanes wherever possible.

Michael Carter, WEST HOLLYOOD, spoke about having protected bike lanes, while avoiding a patchwork approach east of Kings Road. **Dee,** WEST HOLLYOOD, spoke about having sidewalks for pedestrians and another space for wheeled vehicles.

The Commission's comments leaned toward not reducing sidewalks, while amenable to reduction in medians where necessary.

ACTION: Recommend to the City Council to further study the feasibility of bike lanes on the eastside where space allows and explore transitions from street to sidewalk where bike lanes are not feasible.
