Karen expressed interest in the board's activities for Women's History Month and extended an invitation to collaborate on future events or progamming.

A. PRESENTATION ON MULTI-STALL GENDER-NEUTRAL RESTROOMS

Ben Galan, Building and Safety Division Manager from the Planning and Services Development Services Department presented an update to the Women's Advisory Board regarding Multi-stall Gender-Neutral Restrooms.

B. BOYS DON'T WEAR DRESSES FILM SCREENING

The Board received a presentation from Jason Weissbrod of Spectrum Laboratory, about a screening of their award-winning short film, "Boys Don't Wear Dresses", a modern-day fairytale based on Cinderella about a young autistic transgender individual learning about love and independence.

ELECTRONIC RECORD AND SIGNATURE DISCLOSURE
