#### 7. PUBLIC COMMENT:

Karen Eyres is a West Hollywood resident and was a form Boardmemeber of WAB and president of The Hollywood Chapter of the National Organization for Women. She thanked the board for including Hollywood Nows Herstory Award with Women's History month. She informed the board the event will take place on Wednesday, March 15<sup>th</sup> at the CMR. They will be honoring Jane Robinson Flint who is the CEO and co-founder for black women for wellness. She also announced that the California Chapter of NOW will beholding it state capital conference in the City of West Hollywood. The conference will be held on Saturday May 20<sup>th</sup> and are currently working with City Staff on locations where the event can take place. She asked if the board would agendize next month a consideration to co-sponsor of the conference.

#### A. STATUS OF THE EQUAL RIGHTS AMENDMENT (ERA)

Kamala Lopez, Founder/President, Equal Means Equal gave a presentation regarding the current status of the Equal Rights Amendment and the upcoming 100th anniversary of the ERA. They are setting up Happy Birthday Parties for the ERA across the nation on March 22<sup>nd</sup>. They will bring out educational materials.
