5. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA:

ACTION: Approved the Meeting agenda for January 26, 2023. Motion by Board Member Moore, seconded by Board Member De Silva and approved.

6. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES:

7. PUBLIC COMMENT:

Renee Sotile greeted WAB and sent well wishes for Boardmemeber Lane. She thanked the Board for their support on the Silent Witness Project. She reminded the Board of the Rainbow Key Award and informed them that the deadline for nominations is Jan 31st.

8. **NEW BUSINESS:**

A. LEGISLATIVE REVIEW

The Board reviewed an initial list of state bills on prioritized issues compiled by the City's Legislative Analyst.

ACTION: Motion to create a legislative subcommittee to define priorities and review legislative bills by Board Member Moore, seconded by Board Member Payton and approved.

Chair Field, Board Member De Silva, Board Member Lockwood, and Board Member Moore volunteered to be on the subcommittee.

B. NATIONAL SEXUAL ASSAULT AWARENESS AND PREVENTION MONTH

The Board discussed planning for an outreach activity for the City's participation in National Sexual Assault Awareness and Prevention Month during the month of April 2023.

ACTION: Motion to invite WeHo Life to participate in the WAB's outreach activity during National Sexual Assault Awareness and Prevention Month by Chair Field, seconded by Board Member Lane and approved.

Staff liaison, Larissa Fooks, will look for possible dates and circle back to the Board.

C. HOLLYWOOD NOW HERSTORY AWARDS 2023

The Board considered official endorsement of the annual Herstory Awards honoring a local women leader, presented by the Hollywood Chapter of the National Organization for Women during the month of March as part of National Women's History Month.

ACTION: Motion to support the Hollywood Now Herstory Awards for 2023 by Board Member De Silva, seconded by Chair Field, and approved.

The Board discussed next steps regarding advocacy for Sexual Assault Response Teams. Sexual Assault Response Teams (SARTs) help survivors through the maze of community services available to them and uses the experiences of survivors to improve those services.

D. V-DAY COMMEMORATION 2023

Staff liaison, Larissa Fooks, provided an update regarding the Board's recommendation to endorse the City's support of Project Blackbird, a film and discussion program about eating disorders and mental health. The event took place on Saturday, December 3, 2022. The Board debriefed about the event.

ELECTRONIC RECORD AND SIGNATURE DISCLOSURE
