The City of West Hollywood's Homeless Initiative works to address the impacts of homelessness with a collaboration of health and human services specialists, mental health clinicians, substance abuse providers, and law enforcement.

Homeless Services and Concerns for Homeless Individuals

The City offers a variety of services and programs for people experiencing homeless or at risk of homelessness.

The West Hollywood Sheriff's Station addresses law enforcement and safety issues.

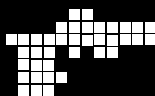
