Arts Coordinator Mike Che invited the Commission to WeHo Reads online event *Inspirations and Intersections* on February 7, celebrating Black History month, April 17, and May 8. Mike shared that the new season of Drag Story Hour begins on February 10, at the West Hollywood Library. Mike mentioned the success of the January 20 *Celebrating Civil Rights Heroes* event and shared that West Hollywood City Poet Laureate Jen Cheng will be providing two free writing workshops on February 3 and March 30. Mike concluded his comments by sharing that the Call for Art Installers (RFQ) closes on February 5, 2024.

Arts Manager Rebecca Ehemann shared that new exhibitions will be displayed on the digital billboards as part of the Moving Image Media Art (MIMA) program on February 1, 2024. Rebecca also offered a brief remembrance celebrating Andrew Campbell.
