SOLID WASTE, RECYCLING, AND ORGANIC WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICE CHARGES FOR COLLECTION ON THE PROPERTY TAX ROLL

CITY OF WEST HOLLYWOOD

FISCAL YEAR 2024/2025

May 28, 2024

INTRODUCTION

The Department of Public Works' solid waste, recycling, and organics waste program has three primary responsibilities: solid waste, recycling, and organics waste collection and disposal which is provided under an exclusive franchise agreement for the entire City, issuing permits to and regulating haulers who provide large containers described as "roll off" containers for construction and demolition waste generated at development sites, and educational programs that inform the public regarding the benefits of recycling and reducing the amount of waste produced.

This report explains the solid waste, recycling, and organics waste collection and disposal services charges proposed for Fiscal Year 2024/2025.

PRIOR AND CURRENT YEAR ANNUAL CHARGES

The City entered into a franchise agreement with a private waste contract hauler, Athens Services, for citywide solid waste, recycling, and organics waste collection and disposal services. Customers are separated into 3 classes:

- Residential customers (4 units or less)
- Residential customers (5 units or more)
- Commercial customers

The Solid Waste and, Recycling, and Organic Waste Collection and Disposal Service Charge is made up of two components.

- 1) The first component is the direct charge paid to the contract hauler. All three classes pay this direct portion.
- 2) The second component is the indirect charge that is an allocation of the Department of Public Works and other City Departments' efforts to manage the solid waste, recycling, and organic waste program. These indirect costs include staff, rent, utilities, and other costs. Both residential customers (4 units or less) and residential customers (5 units or more) pay the indirect portion.

Residential customers (properties with 4 units or less) pay for services by the City placing the direct and indirect charges onto the property tax roll. Residential customers (properties with 5 units of more) pay for services by paying the direct charge directly to Athens Services, while the City places the indirect charge on the property tax roll. Commercial customers pay for services by paying the direct charge directly to Athens Services. Commercial customers do not pay an indirect charge.

The rates for services for each customer class is determined based on: (i) the size of the container serving the property; (ii) the materials accepted in the container (e.g., trash, recyclables, or organic waste) serving the property; and (iii) the frequency of pickups per week.

In November 2022, the franchise agreement with Athens Services was amended to provide the services required by regulations promulgated by CalRecycle to implement SB 1383 (Chapter 395, Statutes of 2016), related to the reduction of Short-Lived Climate Pollutants. The contract was amended to include organic waste collection services and a rate increase to cover the associated costs necessary to implement state mandates related to the SB 1383 requirements and increased costs for solid waste services.

The "City Administrative Fee" is the indirect charge that is an allocation of the Department of Public Works and other City Departments' efforts to manage the solid waste, recycling, and organic waste program. These indirect costs include staff, rent, utilities, outreach, trainings and other costs.

ANNUAL INCREASES

Because the costs of providing solid waste, recycling, and organics services may increase over time due to inflation, the annual rate adjustment includes a Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustment to the direct charge for collection services and the indirect charge for the City Administrative Fee.

A Supplement Adjustment to the direct charge is also included to cover the costs associated with the SB 1383 mandate, spread out over several years.

Annual CPI Adjustment

For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and annually thereafter on each July 1, the direct charge shall be automatically adjusted by the percentage increase in the CPI for Trash and Garbage Collection (CUUR0000SEHG02), United States City Average (not seasonally adjusted), as determined by the United States Department of Labor Statistics, (March of the current year to March of the prior year) plus 1%, provided however, that commencing after July 1, 2027, Trash CPI increase shall not exceed 8% per annum in any Agreement Year. This year's CPI increase is 5.76%. Adding the plus 1% contract provision equals a total Annual Adjustment rate of 6.76%

Supplemental Adjustment

For the period beginning July 1, 2023, and each July 1 up to and through July 1, 2026, the direct charge shall be automatically adjusted by a supplemental adjustment as follows:

Beginning Rate Period	Supplemental Increase

July 1, 2024	+7.5%

July 1, 2025	+5.3%
July 1, 2026	+3.6%

City Administrative Fee Adjustment

For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and annually thereafter on each July 1, the indirect charge shall be automatically adjusted based upon the annual percentage change January to January in the CPI, All Urban Consumers for the Los Angeles-Long Beach-Anaheim, CA Metropolitan Area (not seasonally adjusted), as determined by the United States Department of Labor Statistics. However, the City Administrative Fee shall not be increased by more than 10% in any fiscal year. This year's CPI increase is 2.53%.

Adjustment Total

The 2023-2024 actual and proposed 2024-2025 City Solid Waste Collection Fees and City Recycling Fees are shown in the following table.

A summary of charges by land uses including the high, low, and average assessments for the land use class are attached as Exhibit B. The complete roll showing all parcels and charges is on file in the City Clerk's office and incorporated herein by this reference.

PROPOSITION 218 CONSIDERATIONS

Proposition 218 was approved by the voters of the State of California on November 6, 1996 contains requirements for the imposition of a fee or charge for property-related services. Procedures for the adoption of property-related fees and charges are contained in Section 6 of Article XIII D. The City Council conducted a public hearing regarding the adoption of increased solid waste charges at its June 27, 2022 Council meeting.

Pursuant to Proposition 218, fees or charges must comply with the following five conditions:

- (1) Revenues shall not exceed the funds required to provide the service.
- (2) Revenues shall not be used for any other purpose than that for which the fee or charge was imposed.
- (3) The amount of the fee or charge imposed upon any parcel or person as an incident of property ownership shall not exceed the proportional cost of the service attributable to the parcel.
- (4) No fee or charge may be imposed unless the service is actually used by or immediately available to the property.
- (5) No fee or charge shall be imposed for general governmental services, i.e., police, fire, ambulance, library, where the service is available to the public at large in substantially the same manner as it is to the property owners
- 1) Government Code Section 53756 allows the City to authorize automatic adjustments to property-related charges that are clearly defined by a formula for adjusting for inflation and are for a period not to exceed five years. The multi-year adjustments for inflation have already been approved by the City Council. The change to the Hauler's rates for FY 2023-28 for inflation, which by its very nature covers the increased costs of living and doing business as a result of normal economic conditions, thus do not exceed the cost of providing service.
- 2) Revenues are held separate from other City funds and only used for the solid waste, recycling, and organic waste program.

- 3) Rates are based on the services attributed for residential parcels with 1 to 4 units. Rates are based on the land use code and number of units for trash and recycling services.
- 4) Revenue collected from residential parcels on the property tax bill is based on the County Assessor's records. The City has a program in place for property owners to apply for reimbursement of any payments charged for vacant units.
- 5) Funds for solid waste collection and recycling are specific services provided to each parcel. The City uses other funds for general services to the public at large.

We conclude that the City of West Hollywood City Solid Waste Collection Fee and City Recycling Fee as described in this report satisfies the requirements outline above.

The list of the description of each parcel of real property receiving services and the amount of the charge for each parcel for the year, identified as "FY24 Solid Waste Tax Roll" is on file with the City Clerk and incorporated herein by this reference.
