Under construction for over two years, the dream project in West Hollywood Park is set to open on October 1st (not so coincidentally, the day before the

W. Hollywood Book Fair). It's going to be 32,000 square foot, LEED-certified, and is being billed as a centerpiece of the WeHo community.

Some of the library's features include an LGBT area, HIV/AIDS collection, a children's theatre, an art and design collection and library bookstore.
