The City of West Hollywood has a rich history and unique urban fabric that is known throughout the country and the world.

After only two and a half decades of Cityhood, West Hollywood has established itself as a statewide leader in providing social services to its residents; protecting the rights of all citizens regardless of age, ethnicity, income, or sexual orientation; promoting environmental programs; and implementing progressive housing policies. With a land area of only 1.9 square miles, the City is widely known for its entertainment, arts and design scene and eclectic urban character.

The West Hollywood General Plan 2035, adopted in 2011, provides a roadmap for the City to continue building on its success. It is intended to provide guidance for the next 25 years, with long-term strategies that address the unique characteristics and needs of West Hollywood.
