

Important COVID-19 Health & Safety Guidelines

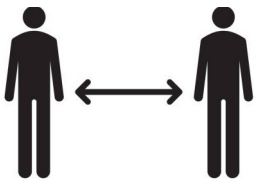
ADVISORY: COVID-19 infections are on the rise in LA County.

COVER YOUR FACE



LA County and the City of West Hollywood require use of face coverings in indoor public settings and strongly recommend face coverings in indoor private common areas and outdoor crowded places.

MAINTAIN YOUR SPACE



It's a good idea to maintain physical distance from others when outside of your household, especially when indoors or in crowds. It's safest at home if you have a pre-existing condition.

WASH HANDS & COVER YOUR COUGH



Regular handwashing is one of the best ways to remove germs, avoid getting sick, and prevent the spread of germs to others. Cover your nose and mouth when coughing and use your elbow.

IF SICK, SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION



If you have a fever, cough, or other symptoms, you might have COVID-19. If you think you've been exposed to COVID-19 or are having trouble breathing, contact a healthcare provider.
